Community Foundation Awards \$135,000 in Grants

Twenty-two local nonprofit organizations were recently awarded \$135,033 in Community Enrichment Grants from the Community Foundation. The great need in our community was reflected by the ninety-eight grant applications we received requesting almost \$1.4 million.

The Grants Review Committee members reviewed applications for many good projects, made site visits and presented their recommendations to the Community Foundation Board. The Board approved the following nonprofit programs for funding. We thank all the nonprofit organizations for the work they do in our community.

*** COMMUNITY ENRICHMENT GRANTS FOR 2010 ***

EDUCATION PROGRAMS: \$22,800

*** Berea Elementary School – \$2,550**

Software program will be purchased to teach teachers conversational Spanish and improve communications with Hispanic parents and academic performance by Hispanic students.

*** Boys Home of the South, Inc. – \$5,000**

Grant will support the Boys to Men Program that teaches young men the necessary tools they need to succeed academically, socially, spiritually and emotionally.

*** Clarity, the Speech, Hearing and Learning Center – \$5,000**

Project will be funded to improve the preschool readiness of children enrolled in a therapeutic daycare/preschool program for abused and neglected children by helping the children, parents, and teaching staff develop speech and language skills.

*** Greenville Literacy Association, Inc. – \$3,250**

Funds will be used to purchase resources that the adult learners will take home for more study and practice to supplement their tutor instruction and to reach their goals.

*** Urban League of the Upstate – \$7,000**

Youth Leadership Development Institute will provide job readiness training, academic support, life skills and leadership training, network building assistance and paid summer work experience.

HEALTH PROGRAMS: \$15,887

*** Faces and Voices of Recovery Greenville – \$2,225**

Funds will provide for consulting services to develop an outcomes measurement plan to assess program effectiveness, provide impetus for program improvement, and build fundraising capacity.

*** Gateway House – \$12,300**

Grant will help fund the In-Home Medication Compliance Project which provides the necessary support and assistance for participants to live independently by resolving medication non-compliance issues.

*** Taylors Free Medical Clinic – \$1,362**

Funds will be used to purchase two digital forehead thermometers and two adult mobile blood pressure units.

SOCIAL SERVICES PROGRAMS: \$90,613

*** Canterbury Counseling Center, A Ministry of Christ Church – \$5,000**

The New Director Project will build the capacity of this pastoral counseling center to provide services to more individuals and families and meet diverse needs without regard to their ability to pay.

*** Genesis Homes – \$12,000**

Project will help fund affordable housing in low-to-moderate income areas by the construction of four houses for senior citizens in the Nicholstown neighborhood.

*** God's Pantry, Mission of Messiah Lutheran Church – \$10,500**

Funds will be used to expand the food pantry capacity to provide boxes of food containing 15 planned meals to clients who can demonstrate need.

*** Greenville Family Partnership – \$5,314**

This grant is for a pilot project to employ and train a part-time bi-lingual outreach worker to inform and educate the Spanish-speaking community on the risks to children.

*** Greenville Rape Crisis and Child Abuse Center – \$10,807**

Prevent Child Abuse Greenville will operate its Parent Education & Support Group program with these funds and provide education and support to parents and caregivers.

*** Meals on Wheels of Greenville, Inc. – \$9,425**

Funding is for Project Transit Connect which will safely transport food prepared and packaged at the downtown facility to pick-up stations for volunteers to deliver the meals to the homebound in Taylors, Travelers Rest, the Furman area and Berea.

*** Project Host, Inc. – \$5,000**

These funds will support the Soup Kitchen which serves disadvantaged individuals and the CC Pearce Culinary School which teaches job skills.

*** Speak for Animals – \$5,067**

This grant will support the Low-Income Spay/Neuter Program by subsidizing the cost to spay/neuter animals for low-income individuals and reduce the number of animals turned in to Greenville County Animal Care Services.

*** Specialized Alternatives for Families and Youth of SC – \$5,000**

These funds will be used for the recruitment and training of foster parents in the Greenville area to serve abused and neglected youth.

*** The Ellen Hines Smith Girls Home – \$5,000**

These funds will be used to implement a model that includes around-the-clock custodial care for girls in foster care who have no other advocates and also teach sustainable skills.

*** Upstate Community Mediation Center – \$4,500**

This funding will engage a consultant experienced in working with nonprofit organizations to assist in developing a business plan and an operational plan to further build the capacity of the mediation center.

*** Wings of Hope Foundation – \$5,000**

This grant will help fund the hiring and training of a Volunteer Coordinator to build community engagement with Serenity Place, a residential treatment program aimed at reducing addiction that results in family collapse and harm to children.

*** YMCA of Greenville: Judson Community Center – \$8,000**

Five hundred books will be bought with this grant for the Book Club initiative which provides afterschool support for fifty-five elementary school students from Hollis Academy.

ENVIRONMENT: \$5,733

*** The Nature Conservancy – South Carolina Chapter – \$5,733**

The Jones Gap Expansion Project will receive these funds to help purchase the White tract and conserve mountain lands for future generations.

Fine art, hands-on activities and creative imaginations abound at the Museum & Gallery at Heritage Green. If you haven't visited yet, be sure to include it in your summer plans. It's an amazing place for both children and adults.

Your experience begins with the current exhibit, The Power of the Portrait, and expands upstairs with exhibits of fashion trends and interactive stations showcasing period clothing, portraiture, photography, and theatre. The activities are fun for all ages. There's even a scavenger hunt to guide kids through the exhibits.

The Children's Learning Center is a creative children's area on the second floor that's filled with things to do and touch that are all related to the exhibit theme. There are games, puzzles, toys, puppets, masks, fabrics, and even a Book Nook Cave that any child would love to crawl into.

M&G also takes the interactive learning experiences outside the walls of the museum and into school with Museum on the Move. These classroom encounters have activities to involve all students. Rima Hourani, the Education Coordinator, is a certified teacher who coordinates the lesson with each teacher to be sure that lesson plan objectives and state standards are met. Home School Fridays provide interactive lessons at the museum for homeschool families and are offered in partnership with the Upcountry History Museum on one Friday each month during the school year.
