Healthy Greenville, Too! is a micro grants program
of the Healthy Greenville grant initiative.

Up to \$100,000 per year will be awarded to qualified, not-for-profit organizations which are not traditional health services delivery organizations and which provide a valuable charitable purpose that improves the well-being of the people of Greenville. One-year grant awards will range of \$5,000-\$25,000.

Grant Principles and Criteria:

- Transparency and open communication in the grantmaking process.
- To encourage and look for opportunities to provide funds for grants that will benefit economically disadvantaged populations within Greenville County.
- Fund projects that will achieve the desired results.
- All grant recipients are required to submit a year-end grant report.
- Three letters of recommendation from elected officials serving Greenville County must accompany the application.
- Healthy Greenville, Too! is an application-only process (no letters of intent).
- Applications will be reviewed by the GHA Grant Committee and awards will be made on or about September 30 by the Greenville Health Authority Board of Trustees.
